Dr. Myron Gottlieb is Vice President and General Manager of the Supply Business Unit at Gas Research Institute (GRI). In this capacity, he directs the development of advanced natural gas technology for finding, producing, and processing natural gas economically from conventional and currently marginal resources.

Dr. Gottlieb earned a B.S. in chemical engineering from Drexel Institute of Technology and a Ph.D. in chemical engineering from the University of Maryland. Before joining GRI in 1981, he conducted research and taught college-level courses at the Institute of Pulp and Paper Chemistry, Appleton, Wisconsin; served as senior process engineer in the chemical industry; and developed environmental control strategies and advanced fossil-fuel energy technologies for the U.S. Department of Energy.
