The objective of the conference was to educate members of industry, federal and state regulatory agencies, academia, public interest groups, and members of the general public on practices and technologies used to prevent pollution; and manage, minimize, treat, and dispose of E&P wastes. More specifically, information was presented relating to source reduction, substitution of less toxic materials for potentially toxic materials, soil and groundwater remediation, naturally occurring radioactive materials, environmental training and education, and innovative and emerging technologies. The conference was held as planned.
