PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

This project is being proposed in two parts, Phase I and Phase II. Phase I is a pilot treatment initiated on the Heintzelman and Kroll leases. The Heintzelman Lease currently has five producing wells. The Heintzelman No.3 was cored and analyzed. The Kroll lease has four producing wells. A water injection well is in the process of being approved by the State Corporation Commission of Kansas. The Kroll No. 6 was cored and analyzed. Phase II would be the expansion of the MEOR process to the remaining wells in the field managed by the Operator.

The treatment strategy includes an initial treatment, followed by treatments every 6 months thereafter. The MEOR materials will be displaced into the target reservoir through the wellbore on all five producing wells in a procedure similar to a conventional matrix squeeze approach. After initial displacement, the wells will be shut-in for a shut-in period specified by the subcontractor.
