Coalition Status and Sustainability

- Current Status
 - Coordinator works part time as Executive Director for the coalition and the rest of his time for Florida Solar Energy Center. The Non-profit coalition has a 9 member Board of Directors.
- Membership Structure / Strategies
 - Membership is obtained through contacts from meetings, public officials, advertising, word of mouth and web page. Present dues structure is based on organization they represent with fees of \$25 for Friend, \$50 General, \$100 public and \$200 industry.
- Steps to Become Self-Sustaining
 - The Coalition has a Sustainability Plan in place with funding sources of grants, dues, sponsorships, Carbon Angle credits and in-kind efforts for coalition activities.



Significant/Noteworthy Projects & Activities

- Vehicle projects
 - 90 Orange County Schools Busses get diesel oxidation catalyst
- Fueling infrastructure projects
 - Developed conversion of biomass to synthetic liquid fuels
 - Compliance of all gasoline pumps to E10
 - Demonstrated Photovoltaic charging of NEVs at KSC
 - Development of Photovoltaic charging of NEVs in Orlando
- Coalition outreach activities
 - Science Fair awards for alternative fuel projects
 - Conducted a summer camp course on “How to buy an AFV”
 - Motorweek show on AFV implementation at Kennedy Space Center
- Portfolio activities (i.e. idle reduction, hybrids, blends, fuel economy)
 - Dump the Pump and Ride Day program to use Lynx buses and not your car
 - Student Idle Patrol where students gave tickets for parents and other for idling
