- Coordinator Status
 - South Shore Clean Cities is a Full-Time Coordinator Position
 - 40 hours per week devoted to Coordinator Duties
- Coalition Staff
 - Carl & Lorrie Lisek serve as Co-Coordiators for SSCC
 - Part-time staff assists with coalition responsibilities
 - Contracted website management
- Ability to Delegate Coalition Work?
 - Working as Co-Coordiators provides a “safety net” for SSCC.

- **Coalition Location**

- Our company recently moved into the NWI Purdue Technology Center which also provides a great opportunity for SSCC.
- SSCC is a non-profit coalition.

- **Coalition Organization**

SSCC is governed by a 15 member Board of Directors
Executive Board consists of 2 Co-Chairs and a Treasurer
Vehicle & Infrastructure and Education & Outreach Committees
Coordinators take direction from the Board of Directors.

- **Coalition Meetings**

- SSCC Board of Directors meet on a monthly basis.
- Annual Coalition Meeting in February to select our Board of Directors
- Several Education and Outreach Coalition Meetings annually

2008 Annual Survey

- # of Stakeholders = 69
- Total GGEs Displaced = 570,830 gallons

2009 Annual Survey

- # of Stakeholders = 89
- Total GGEs Displaced = 229,374 gallons

- SSCC added 25 new members in 2009.
- SSCC E85 on I65 Grant Participant implementing Alternative Fuel Stations
- Indiana currently has 180 Alternative Fueling Stations – 117 E-85
- Due to SSCC Participation in CMAQ funding in Lake, Porter and LaPorte Counties over 200 AFV's were added to municipal fleets in 2009
- In 2010, every community in Lake, LaPorte and Porter Counties will receive at least one AFV

Statistic Challenges

- In 2009, a major utility in our area requested we remove all their CNG stations from our station locator.
- GGE's in 2008 included a bus company that was serving our area and using biodiesel. The contract was not renewed in 2009 therefore numbers are not reflected in our totals.

\$360,000 Project for School Buses & Municipal Equipment

Implementing AFV's into municipal fleets including infrastructure
and education/outreach

FAIR OAKS DAIRY

- Implementation of Biomass into a transportation fuel.

HOSTED A SMARTWAY EVENT AT HORSESHOE CASINO

- Partnered with State and Federal Agencies over 160 attendees

SSCC continues to work with Mittal Steel, US Steel, Indiana Tollroad, Port of Indiana and Horseshoe Casino on the implementation of alternative fuels and idle reduction technologies.

 - Involvement with NIRPC and the CMAQ Process
 - Working with Regional Development Authority
 - Working with NWI Small Business Development Center
 - Moving to the Purdue Technology Center
 - Seeking additional Grant Funding for SSCC and our members

- SSCC Membership Funding Goal for 2010 - \$60,000
- SSCC will continue to build partnerships and secure grant funding for projects working toward sustainability.

- In 2010, SSCC **will finally** receive CMAQ funding for projects in Northern Indiana – SSCC has been working for three years to secure this funding!!
