**Carbon Storage R&D Project Review Meeting:
Developing Carbon Storage Technologies and Infrastructure
Sheraton Station Square, Pittsburgh, PA, August 12-14, 2014**

You are cordially invited to attend Department of Energy's (DOE) 2014 Carbon Storage R&D Project Review meeting at the Sheraton Station Square Hotel in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, USA, August 12-14, 2014. This year's technical plenary session will focus on the Regional Carbon Sequestration Partnership's (RCSP) large-scale field projects and other carbon storage technical and topical updates. Parallel technical sessions will cover research from infrastructure projects; geologic storage projects; monitoring, verification and accounting (MVA) projects; simulation and risk assessment projects; and CO₂ use/re-use projects. The Infrastructure technical session will highlight the most current updates on additional small-scale field and characterization projects. Invited presentations will focus on regulatory issues, government-industry collaborations, and large-scale international storage efforts.

Interactive reception/poster sessions will be held to highlight related work being performed throughout carbon storage in the United States and Internationally. Posters are encouraged from DOE National Laboratories, International demonstration projects, subcontractors participating in Carbon Storage projects, and other organizations conducting research on carbon storage. The poster sessions are an excellent networking opportunity with colleagues conducting research on carbon storage. Participants will share knowledge and resources to assist in planning future carbon storage efforts. Based on past attendance, this meeting is expected to attract 200 or more attendees.
