You are cordially invited to attend the 2015 Carbon Storage Research and Development (R&D) Project Review Meeting on August 18-20, 2015 at the Sheraton Station Square Hotel, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

The Carbon Storage R&D Project Review Meeting, sponsored by the U.S. Department of Energy's (DOE) National Energy Technology Laboratory, is open to all interested parties. The meeting will include three days of plenaries including technical updates from the Regional Carbon Sequestration Partnership's large-scale field projects, as well as from international monitoring and offshore storage efforts. Invited plenary presentations include introductions to DOE's Subsurface Technology and Engineering Research, Development, and Demonstration (SubTER) Crosscut initiative and the Energy Frontier Research Centers in DOE's Office of Science. Parallel technical sessions conducted in the afternoons will cover research from infrastructure projects; geologic storage projects; monitoring, verification and accounting projects; simulation and risk assessment projects; and CO<sub>2</sub> use/re-use projects.

Interactive poster sessions will highlight research being conducted throughout the U.S. and internationally, including hands-on demonstrations with toolsets developed by the National Risk Assessment Partnership. Posters are encouraged from all DOE national laboratories, international demonstration projects, subcontractors participating in carbon storage projects, and other organizations conducting research on carbon storage. The poster sessions are an excellent networking opportunity with colleagues conducting research on carbon storage. Participants will share knowledge and resources to assist in planning future carbon storage efforts. Based on past attendance, this meeting is expected to attract 200 or more attendees.

In addition to researchers, participants may include employees of other government agencies, electric utilities, research organizations, small and large businesses, and regulatory agencies at the federal, state, and local levels.
