 - Grade
 - Name of teacher(s) or group leader(s)
 - School's name and phone number
- Teacher(s) and/or group leader(s) **must** complete a typed *School Entry Information Form* (see page 2) with all students' names to allow preparation of the certificates. A hard copy must be sent with posters.
- We apologize, but submitted posters cannot be returned.
- Posters will be judged on 4 criteria:
 - Theme-Focus... *"Protect Our Earth's Plants, Care for Its Creatures"*
 - Demonstrate ways to protect the Earth's Precious Natural Resources - Plants & Animals (Importance of Recycling, Energy Conservation, & Improving Air Quality)
 - Originality
 - Imagination
